All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only)	Total: £2010.01
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.	
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£725
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care	£265
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. <i>The deceased person will be kept at our only premises, The Private Chapel, Church Street, Horwich.</i>	£250
Providing a suitable coffin – this will be made from Oak Veneer	£475
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)	£0.01
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£295
UNATTENDED FUNERAL	
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.	
Burial (funeral director's charges only)	£1100
Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee)²	£1400
FEE'S YOU MUST PAY	
For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee . ¹	
In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is:	£730-£918
For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.	
For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee . ²

¹ This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

² In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.

Our Terms of Business

1. Deposit: We require a deposit to cover the cost of disbursements paid out on your behalf, to be paid in advance of the funeral.
2. Please let us know if there is a solicitor dealing with the account and we will liaise with them regarding payment.
3. Payment is due within 30 days of the invoice date, we accept cash, cheque, most major debit and credit cards and BACS (preferred method) to our account.
4. Unattended/direct cremation- the full invoice to be paid in full prior to the funeral taking place.
5. Non payment: If we do not receive payment we will work with you to create a payment plan. If we still do not receive payment we reserve the right to charge interest as follows: at a rate of 4% above our bank's Base Rate from time to time in force; calculated monthly from the date of our account until payment is received. We will recover the cost of taking legal action to make you pay.
